Dear Parents/Guardians,

This year we commemorate our fourteenth ANZAC Dawn Service, which will be held on the morning of **Friday 12 April 2019**. The start and finish times of the school day will be altered to incorporate the service. I have sought permission from the Department to alter the instructional hours for the day; this means that **all students K-6 will finish school at 12:00 pm**. We recognise these changes may cause logistical problems for some families; however, we trust that you will understand that **all staff will commence at 5:00 am**. We hope all students and many parents will join us for this special event.

- 5.35am** A bell will ring at 5.35am to form classes on paved area outside Room 8 for Years 1–6 as practiced.

- 5.50am** All guests, family and students seated for the Dawn Service to commence.
- 7.15am** Breakfast is available for students, families and invited guests at the conclusion of the service. It will include muffins, toast, juice, tea, coffee and milo.
