Interschool Athletics Selection Policy.

The CSSDA promotes the concept of maximum participation for the winter sports fixtures, Lightning Carnival and school's individual faction carnivals (refer to code of conduct policy).

The Interschool Athletics Carnival, however, is the opportunity for a school's elite athletes to directly compete against those from other schools. Member schools aim to select the best athletes from their respective school using clear selection procedures which are fair to all students. The selection procedures listed below have been agreed to by all CSSDA Member schools as the procedures they will use to select their interschool team members.

- 1. Each school will conduct a Faction/House Athletics Carnival. These should allow for maximum participation and include all events that are listed on the programme of interschool athletics events.
- For individual events and relays, the selection of interschool representatives
 will be based on the finishing order in the Faction Carnival. Student who were
 present and competed in the Faction Carnival may not challenge for the
 successful students position. (Unless he/she broke down or fell during the
 selection race)
- 3. A child may only challenge for a successful student's position if they were unable to compete on carnival day due to absence or injury. NB. RELAY TEAMS. In some school carnivals where faction based heats are run, the situation can occur where the three or four best runners are in the same faction. This means that the third fastest runner in a year level may not make the division 1 race. Therefore, a single run off between the third/fourth runner in div 1 and the third/fourth runner in each faction may be necessary.
- 4. Any challenge made must be completed by the Friday prior to team submissions being due to the organising school. These submissions are due on the Monday one week before the interschool carnival. Any child returning from absence or injury after this date may not challenge.

- 4. Any challenge made must be completed by the Friday prior to team submissions being due to the organising school. These submissions are due on the Monday one week before the interschool carnival. Any child returning from absence or injury after this date may not challenge.

(Note: The date in 2015 is Tuesday, 8th September).
