2020 SCHOOL CHARGES AND CONTRIBUTIONS**



Dear Parents

The Poynter Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2020. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

1. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions and activities for 2020 has been included in the table attached. Details on charges collected in previous years has helped guide the 2020 estimate of charges. The amounts shown represent the **maximum** charges for scheduled activities in 2020.

The schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities and available to **all students**, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions and excursions.
- Specific learning activities available to **selected students**, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. PEAC, HOTS, IMSS, music programs, etc.
- Other activities available to **all students** in specific year groups, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. graduation dinner/social, camps, interschool events, etc.

NB: We introduced a PAYG system in 2019 via the QKR app which includes online permission. This will become our main permission/payment method in 2020 with notifications and information via Connect.

2. Personal Use Items

The list of items for personal use will vary from student to student and includes:

- Pupil requirements for all students and used in lessons e.g. stationery items, calculator, etc.
- Pupil requirements recommended but not essential for all students e.g. tissues, art shirt, etc.

The recommended list of items for Personal Use for your child has been previously distributed. All materials can be purchased through Ziggies; **however, you are not obliged to use this supplier.**

Your child will need to have the listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items, such as pens or pencils, throughout the year.

- Pupil requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program e.g. class photographs, etc.
- Year 3 to 6 French workbooks will be provided at school by Ziggies at the beginning of the year to ensure suitable levels per child. Payment is requested on the Pupil Requirements.

3. Voluntary School Contribution

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are requested to pay has been set at \$60.00 per student (Years K-6) which is in line with the Department of Education Contributions, Charges & Fees Policy.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. The table below gives you the breakdown of where we will direct your voluntary contribution to.

The School Board would like to point out that the contribution per child equates to \$1.50 per week over the course of the school year (i.e. 40 weeks).

4. Voluntary P&C Contribution

The Poynter Primary School P&C Association voluntary approved request will again be **\$70.00 per family**. This payment is made to the school and passed onto the P&C who manage the expenditure to supplement fundraising efforts.

The P&C fund a wide range of items which benefit your children's education and development, including educational programs such as Mathletics and RazKids, playground equipment, sports activities and other items that fall outside the school budget. Again, this equates to \$1.75 per week.
