

POYNTER PRIMARY SCHOOL 2023 SCHOOL CHARGES AND CONTRIBUTIONS

Dear Parents

The Poynter Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2023. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

1. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions and activities for 2023 has been included in the table attached. Details on charges collected in previous years has helped guide the 2023 estimate of charges (2022 notwithstanding). The amounts shown represent the **maximum** charges for scheduled activities in 2023.

The schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities and available to **all students**, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions and excursions.
- Specific learning activities available to **selected students**, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. PEAC, HOTS, IMSS, music programs, etc.
- Other activities available to **all students** in specific year groups, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. graduation dinner/social, camps, interschool events, etc.

NB: QKR is the 'pay as you go' (PAYG) system that we use and includes online permission. This is our main permission/payment method with notifications and information sent via Connect, and is in line with the local high schools. **Full payment needs to be made no later than the day before the activity, otherwise the student will not be able to participate.**

2. Personal Use Items

The list of items for personal use will vary from student to student and includes:

- Pupil requirements for all students and used in lessons e.g. stationery items, workbooks, calculator, etc.
- Pupil requirements recommended but not essential for all students e.g. tissues, art shirt, etc.

The recommended list of items for Personal Use for your child will be distributed electronically. All materials can be purchased through Champion; **however, you are not obliged to use this supplier.**

Your child will need to have the listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items, such as pens or pencils, throughout the year.

- Pupil requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program e.g. class photographs, etc.

3. Voluntary School Contribution

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are requested to pay has been set at **\$60.00 per student** (Years K-6) which is in line with the Department of Education Contributions, Charges & Fees Policy.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. The table below gives you the breakdown of where we will direct your voluntary contribution.

5. Voluntary P&C Contribution

The Poynter Primary School P&C Association voluntary approved request will again be **\$70.00 per family**. This payment is made to the school and passed onto the P&C who manage the expenditure to supplement fundraising efforts.

The P&C partially fund a wide range of items which benefit your children's education and development.
